Election Procedures: Requires Consideration and Adoption by Caucus Members Prior to Election

- Nominations
 - Nomination for each office is taken from the floor
 - Credentialed members are eligible to participate
 - Rules do not prohibit candidates running for office positions in absentia
 - The order of nomination should follow the order prescribed above
 - After the close of nomination for an office, move on to the nomination for the next office, until nomination for every office is conducted
(May be posed as a motion to the body to close nomination for each office)
- Candidate speeches
 - Each candidate may speak for one minute
 - The Caucus may elect to limit speeches only in contested races
(May be posed as a motion to the body)
- Voting
 - For those offices that are uncontested, the Caucus may move to vote by acclamation
 - For those offices that are contested
 - The Caucus may decide to conduct vote by showing credential cards (vote by hand), or
 - The Caucus may decide to conduct vote by ballot (note: no secret balloting per CDP rules)
- Results
 - Candidate garnering the majority vote in each office wins

CDP API Caucus Bylaws Article IV. Section 5. Election of Officers

- A. All statewide officers shall be elected before the conclusion of the CDP State Convention in odd-numbered years. All regional officers will be elected in their respective regions at the same time.
- B. Candidate for office must be a full member of the Caucus in good standing for at least 30 days prior to the election.
- C. All officers shall be elected by a majority of those present and voting.
- D. Elections shall be conducted according to the procedure established by the Executive Board and adopted by the Caucus prior to each election.
